



Bay Shore Rules and Policies

These rules are designated for your safety and to foster a friendly atmosphere with consideration for your neighbor.

1. **All guests must be prepaid**
2. **One family per lot. Maximum of six persons**
3. Whirlpool – 18 years and older
4. **NO FLOATS OF ANY KIND ALLOWED IN THE POOL (including life jackets)**
5. **No child under 12 years old is permitted in the pool without an adult**
6. No motorbikes or golf carts allowed
7. **No dogs over 35 lbs. or of a vicious breed are allowed** - Dogs are to be kept on a short leash and not left unattended at any time. Dogs are not allowed in any building, pool, playground, or dock area. Please pick up after your dog and use proper disposal
8. **An extension of the permit tag must be obtained prior to 2:00 pm the day it expires**
9. **Only one vehicle allowed per lot.** Extra vehicles must have a permit tag from the office and should be kept in our overflow parking lot behind the playground – this includes your guests
10. **No boats allowed on lots.** They must be stored in an area storage facility
11. All garbage must be deposited in our garbage dumpsters
12. Quiet in the evenings is appreciated by other campers – keep noises at a minimum after 10:00 pm.
13. Children under 12 years old must be at campsite **by dark**. Those 13 to 16 years old must be at campsite by 11:00 pm; and 16 year old and older must be at campsite by 12:00 midnight
14. No bikes after dark
15. **Please kindle fires in designated places only (fire ring).** Leaving a fire unattended is prohibited. All fires must be extinguished by 1:00 a.m.
16. Any use of firearms or fireworks in the park is prohibited
17. **NO REFUNDS** except for emergency reasons only
18. No person will be permitted to by-pass the electric gate
19. This park is maintained with YOUR money. Treat it as you would your own property. Keep your campsite clean. You will enjoy it more and so will your neighbors and rent will be kept to a minimum
20. Campers must abide by Park Rules not listed here
21. **We assume no responsibilities for loss or damage to property or for personal injury to occupants or visitors**
